Uganda is a recipient of Grants from the Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria (“the Global Fund”), an international partnership that provides grants to lower income countries with high disease burden for elimination of the three diseases. The Grants are provided through the Ministry of Finance, Planning and Economic Development (MoFPED) and the Uganda AIDS Support Organisation (TASO) as Principal Recipients for the public sector and non-public sector interventions respectively.

Grants are provided for implementation over a period of three (3) years. Implementation of the current Grant under Grant Cycle 7 (GC7) commenced on 1st January 2024.

The Funds Coordination Unit (FCU) for the Global Fund Grants was set up under the Ministry of Finance, Planning and Economic Development to facilitate the role of the Public Sector Principal Recipient, including provision of oversight implementation of the Grants.

The Ministry requires the services of a qualified and experienced professional to work as Senior Risk Management Officer for the FCU for a period of one year, renewable up to three years based on need and satisfactory performance.
