# Key Facts on Delegation Agreement

- **Name of action:** Enhancing Climate Resilience through increased Water for Production Capacities in Karamoja
- **Contract holder:** Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH
- **Implementing partners:**
  - ❑ Ministry of Water and Environment (MWE) with the respective departments -
  - ❑ Directorate Water Resources Management (DWRM) – Kyoga Water Management Zone (KWMZ)
  - ❑ Directorate Water Development (DWD) – Department Water for Production (DWfP) – Water for Production Regional Centre East (WfPRC-E)



# Key Facts on Delegation Agreement

- **Implementation duration:** December 2017 – August 2019 (extension until July 2020 will be requested by GIZ)
- **Areas of implementation:**
  - ❑ Kaabong – Loyoro, Kakamar, Kaabong West, Kapedo
  - ❑ Kotido – Kacheri, Kotido, Panyangara, Nakapelimoru
  - ❑ Moroto – Nadunget, Rupa, Katikekile,
  - ❑ Amudat – Loro, Karita
- **Expected beneficiaries/target groups:** permanent communities in the vicinity of the valley tank – up to 20,000 beneficiaries



# Brief description of the actions

- Outline of key result areas and actions.
- **Water storage capacity in Karamoja is sustainably increased**

## Activities:

- Up to 15 valley tanks are newly construction or rehabilitated and water source protection measures are implemented
- For these valley tanks gender sensitive water user agreements are developed and signed between the MWE and the water user committees
- Operation & Maintenance strategy and implementation plan for sustainable management of water for production facilities is developed
- Management and technical manual on operation & maintenance for water for production facilities is developed



## Brief description of the actions

- Outline of key result areas and actions.
- **Capacity of deconcentrated units of the MWE are strengthened**

### Activities:

- Upper Nile Water Management Zone and Kyoga Water Management Zone publish an annual zonal water resources management status report
- Revision of DWRMs strategy for operationalization of catchment-based watershed management
- Support to MWE in integration of Catchment Management Plans into District Development Plans in Adjumani District

## Progress to date

- Locations for rehabilitation and new valley tanks in 4 Districts are specified
- Financing Agreement with MoFPED / MWE drafted
- Participatory Rural Appraisal (PRA) in eight locations for rehabilitation of valley tanks and implementation of water source protection measures carried out
- Procurement of consultant for O&M guidelines and CbWRM strategy ongoing
- Integration of CMP into DDP ongoing
- Consultant for support annual zonal water resources management status report on board





# Potential complementarities/Synergies with DINU Call

- ▶ GIZ activities are linked to DINU specific objectives SO1 and SO3
- ▶ SO 1: increased food security, improve maternal and child nutrition, and enhance household incomes through support to diversified food production and commercial agriculture and through improving household resilience (notably to climate change) and women empowerment
- ▶ SO 3: to strengthen capacity, gender-responsive good governance (core mandate and general broad mandate) and the rule of law at the level of local government authorities and empower communities to participate in improved local service delivery.
- ▶ and focus on Karamoja region
- ▶ Potential activities listed in the Catchment Management Plans of Lokok and Lokere (Investment Plans) with focus on
  - ▶ Institutional strengthening
  - ▶ Ecosystem protection and restoration
  - ▶ Agriculture and economic development
  - ▶ Water and sanitation
