01	In section 3: Evaluation methodology and criteria 3.2 (i) item require us to send the return of allotment of company shares and a copy of the National Identity Card or Passport of the majority shareholders. But we are the Chinese state owned company, the individual shareholder is Chinese Government, there is no such document above mentioned, can we substitute it with the Article of Association?	Show proof that the individual shareholder is Chinese Government. You can do this by submitting the Articles of Association and copy of passport of individual shareholders
02	The social economic consideration requires that 70% of the technical team made up of local manpower. What we want to clarify is about the technical team, is the technical team formed by the technical personnel only from key staff, or from the whole construction team?	The technical team will be formed from only the required key staff.
03	Financial evaluation criteria 8.1 (a) all associated design and construction supervision services fees. What is the meaning of fees? Is the fees for supervision services taken by us, or consultant hired by employer	For clarity, please refer to the contract sum analysis provided. Bidders are to include the fees for design and supervision by the Contractor's Design Team (CDT) in their cost breakdown.
04	As far as the key staff, procuring documents requires the evidence of experience, academic qualifications, professional registration certificates and valid practicing certificates for the key personnel. We want to know what the valid practicing certificate is, according to our understanding, it may be the	Professional staffs usually register once with their professional bodies. The professional bodies then require that members are fully subscribed and issue valid practicing certificates in turn. The professional registration certificate is therefore different from the practicing certificate. For further clarity, Professionals must be valid to practice in
